How to become a Christian according to the Bible?

A- Admit that you are a sinner that has offended a holy God and is guilty of condemnation; and that you cannot save yourself and need a Saviour. Jesus said **“He came to seek & save those that are lost”**. Luke 19:10 **“I didn't come to call those who think they are good but for those who know they are sinners to repentance”**. Luke 5:32 **“For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God”**. Romans 3:23 **As it is written: “There is none righteous or good, no, not one”**. Romans 3:10 **“For whoever keeps the whole law, and yet breaks one point, they are guilty of all”**. James 2:10 **“For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord”**. Romans 6:23 **“Believers are not condemned but unbelievers are condemned already...”**. John 3:18

B- Believe in Jesus Christ by trusting Him as your Lord (master) and Saviour (deliverer). Believe in your heart that Jesus died on the cross for you to pay the penalty of your sins and rose from the dead to give you a new life. **“If you declare with your mouth, “Jesus is Lord,” and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. For it is with your heart that you believe and are justified, and it is with your mouth that you profess your faith and are saved”**. Romans 10:9,10 **“Only those who received Him and believed on His name were given the power or right to become the children of God”**. John 1:12

C- Confess Jesus publicly by asking him to save you and publicly declare him through your testimony, baptism, communion, church fellowship and witness. **“Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved.” Romans 10:13 “Whoever acknowledges me before others, I will also acknowledge before my Father in heaven. But whoever denies me before others, I will deny before my Father in heaven”**. Matthew 10:32,33

Suggested Prayer: “Dear Jesus forgive me of my sins and come into my life to make me your child and follower. I believe you died on the cross for me and rose from the dead to give me a new life and identity in yourself. I come to the end of myself by surrendering myself to you; and give you control of my whole life. In Jesus name I pray. Amen!”
